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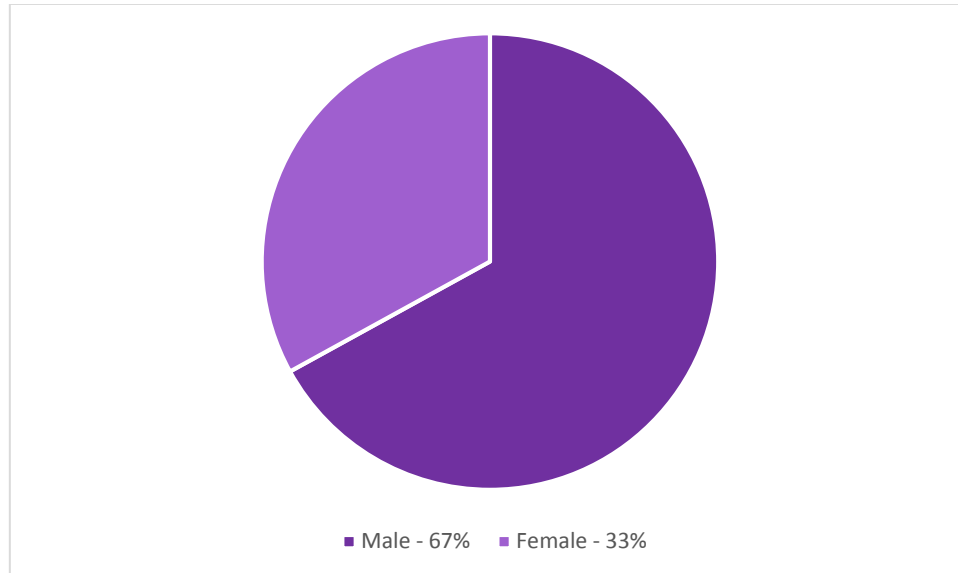
Introduction

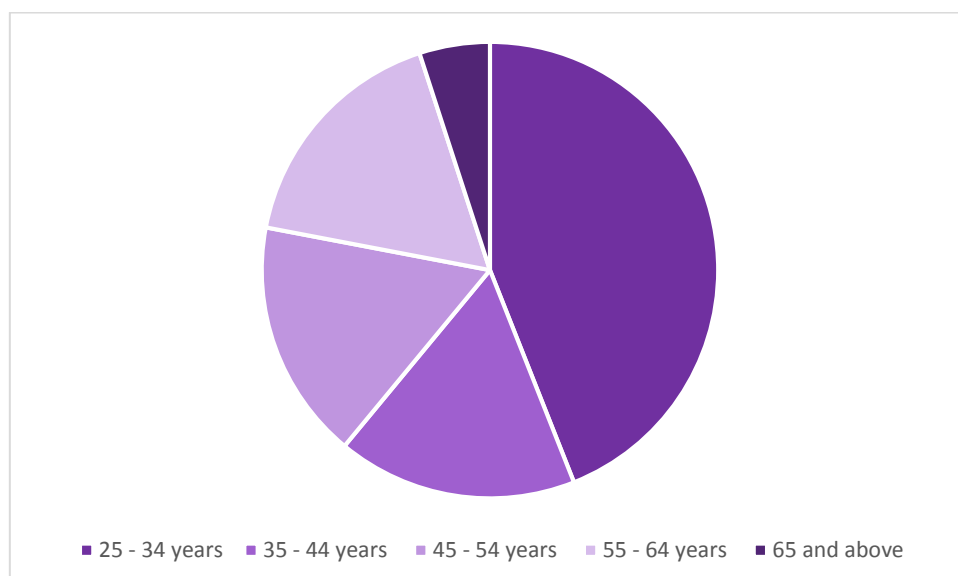
Question 1: Gender

Question: Please indicate your gender



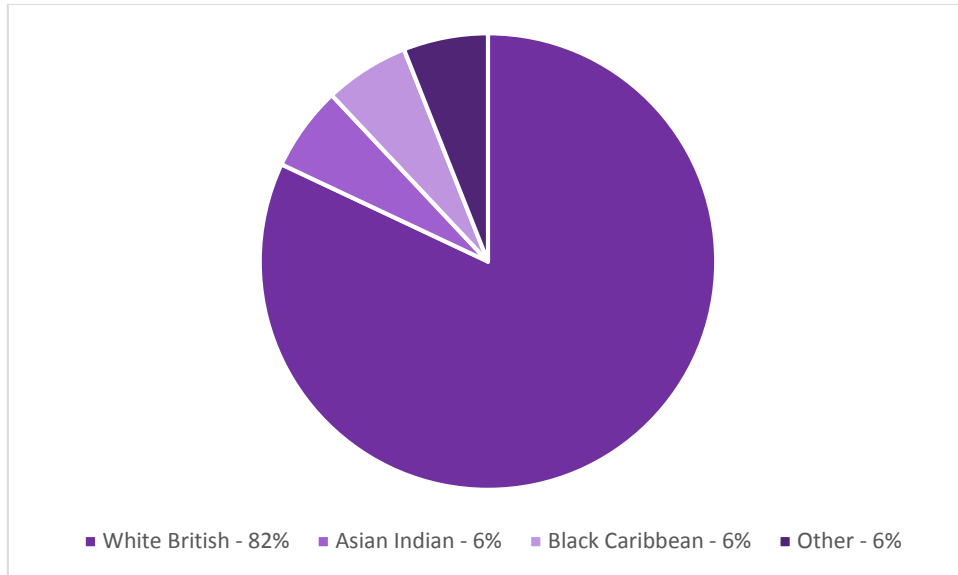
Question 2: Age

Question 3: Ethnic Group

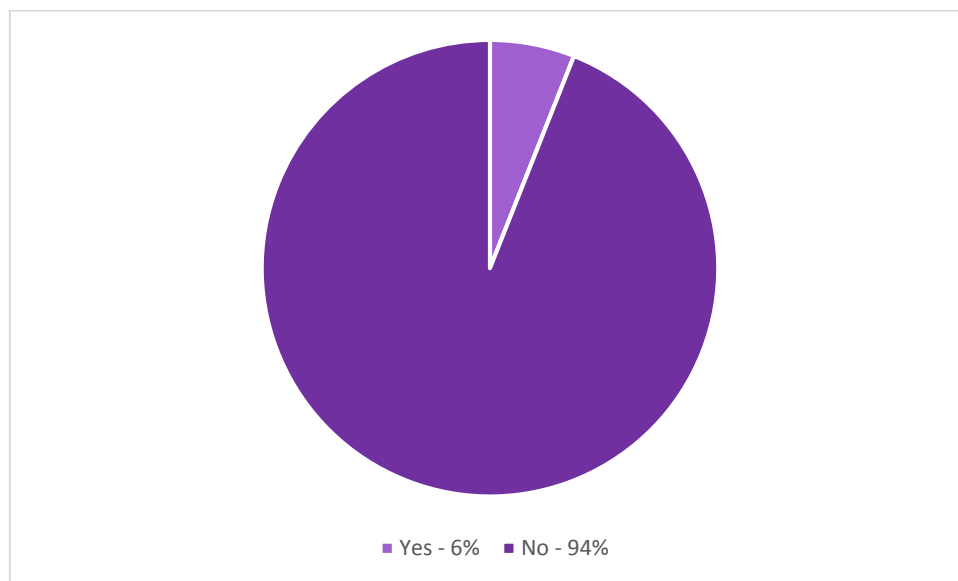
What is your ethnic group?



Question 4: Disability

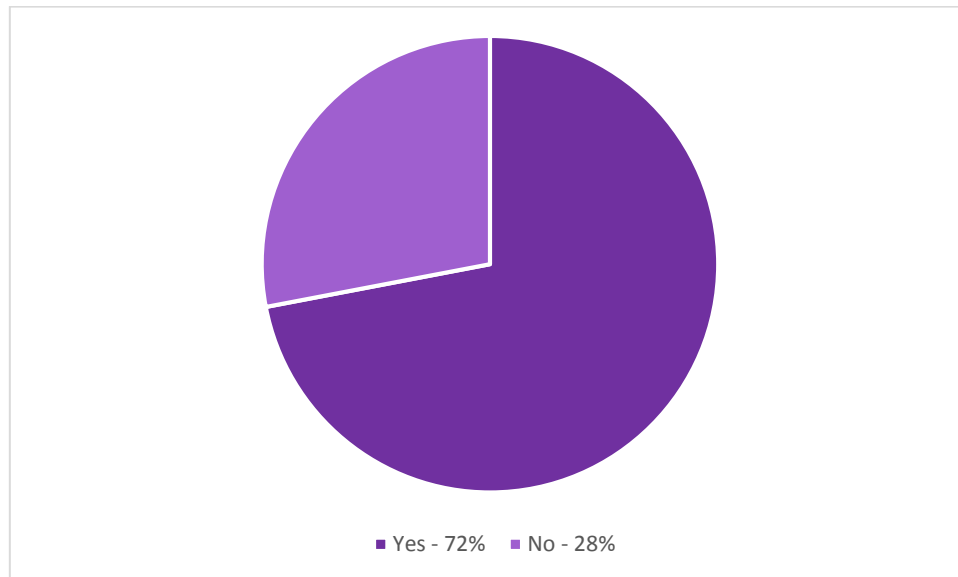
Do you consider yourself to have a disability?

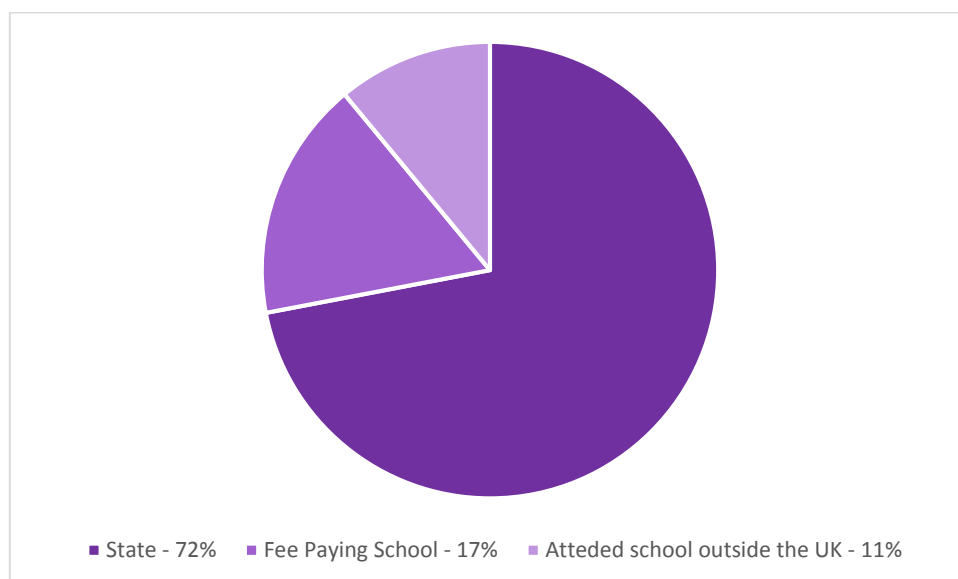
Question 7: University

If you went to university (to study a BA, BSc course or higher) were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?



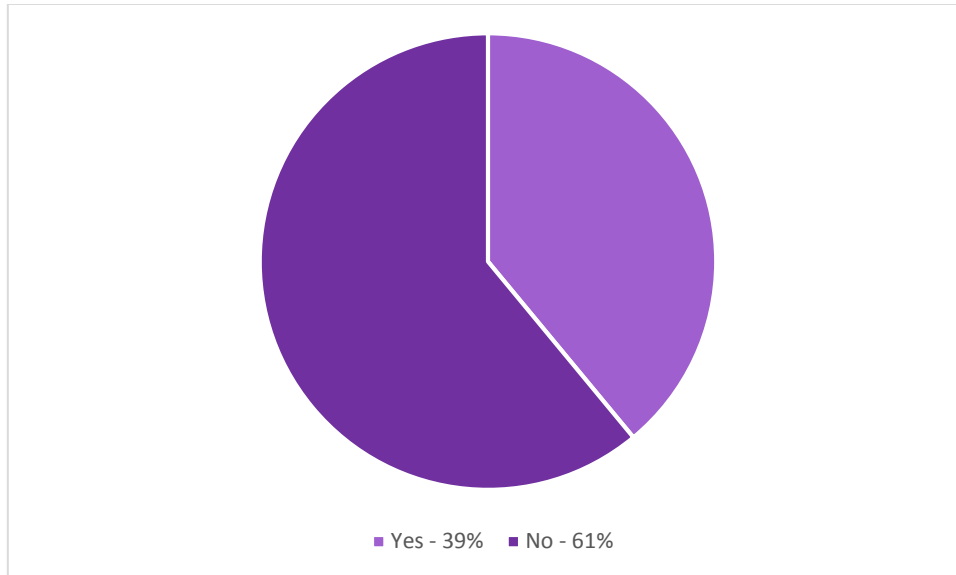
Question 8: Schooling
