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Introduction




The questionnaire response data has been collected and processed in accordance with the Data Protection Principles as set out in the General Data Protection Regulation.

Question: Please indicate your gender




Question: Is your gender the same as the sex that you were registered at birth?




Section 2: Age

Section 3: Ethnic Group


Question: What is your ethnic group?




Section 4: Disability & Health

The Equality Act 2010 defines a person as having a disability if he or she has a physical or mental impairment, which has a substantial long term, adverse effect on his or her ability to carry out normal day-to-day activities. "Long term" means the impairment is likely to or has lasted for 12 months or more.




Question: Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?




Section 5: Education

Question: If you went to university (to study a BA, BSc course or higher) were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?




Question: Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages of 11-18?
